Dear agents of the United States, Thanks to "Lexis Advance", accessible to me electronically on my home computer for a monthly fee of \$176.40/month is following 1959-1972 regulatory history of the rules prescribed by the Administrative Committee of the Federal Register (ACFR) with respect to the indexing of the Federal Register. It was so convenient to be able to find such documents and then print each one as tangible proof of the actions of the ACFR. Take that up until November 4, 1972, the **daily contents of the Federal Register** were prescribed to be **indexed under the names of the issuing agencies**. Although such agency indexing has never been codified with respect to the **yearly contents** of the Federal Register, **the ACFR has secretly authorized it with the approval of the Archivist and the Attorney General**. As of **March 26, 1959** (24 FR 2351), the ACFR prescribed:

**1 CFR § 18.1-The daily contents of the FEDERAL REGISTER shall be appropriately indexed under the names of the issuing agencies.**

**1 CFR § 18.2-Analytical subject indexes shall be separately published covering the contents of the FEDERAL REGISTER as follows: Monthly for the months of January, February, April, May, July, August, October, November and December; quarterly for the quarters ending in March, June and September; and annually for the calendar year.**

**1 CFR § 14.1-The daily contents of the FEDERAL REGISTER shall be appropriately indexed under the names of the issuing agencies.**

**1 CFR § 14.2-Analytical subject indexes covering the contents of the FEDERAL REGISTER shall be published as currently practicable, and shall be cumulated and separately published at least once each calendar year.**
