Dear Dr. James V.M.L. Holzer,

Martin Henning, FDIC Acting CIO/CPO asked that I respond to the Office of Government Information Services (OGIS) September 16, 2015 suggestion that FDIC consider adding a new routine use to its FOIA and Privacy Act System of Records Notice. The FDIC is encouraged by this OGIS initiative and pleased to learn that OGIS is beginning to realize administrative process efficiencies with respect to those agencies that have adopted the suggested routine use. After carefully considering the OGIS suggestion, the FDIC has determined that adopting the routine use would be incompatible with the FDIC's well-established FOIA and Privacy Act program protocols. The FDIC believes strongly in obtaining written consent prior to releasing personally identifiable information. By adding this new routine use, affected individuals would lose this important consent activity, that we believe is more closely aligned with the Privacy Act's intended protections.

Thank you for your efforts to promote open government and for considering FDIC in with respect to this initiative.
