- Other: dry chemical; solid propellants









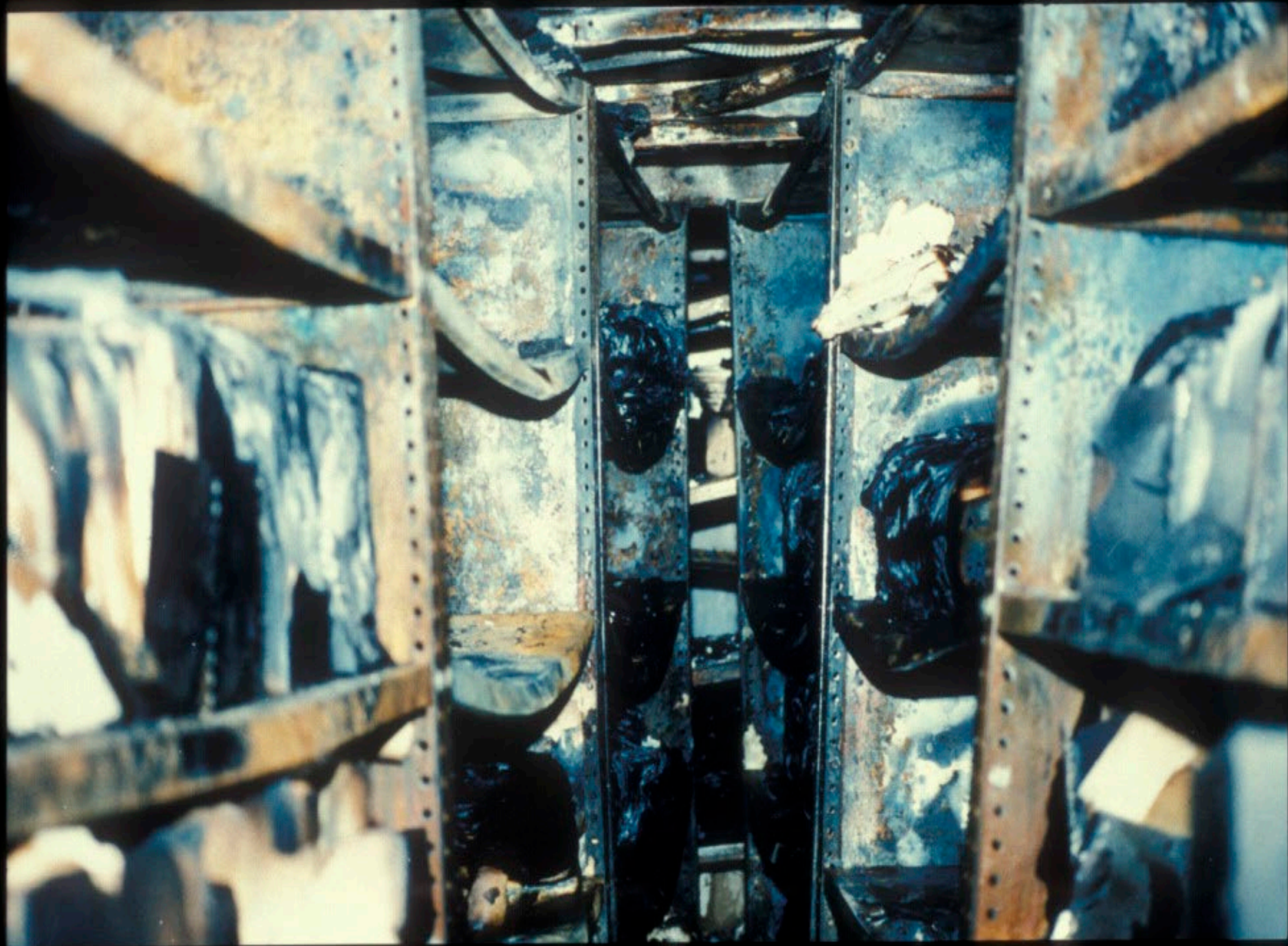






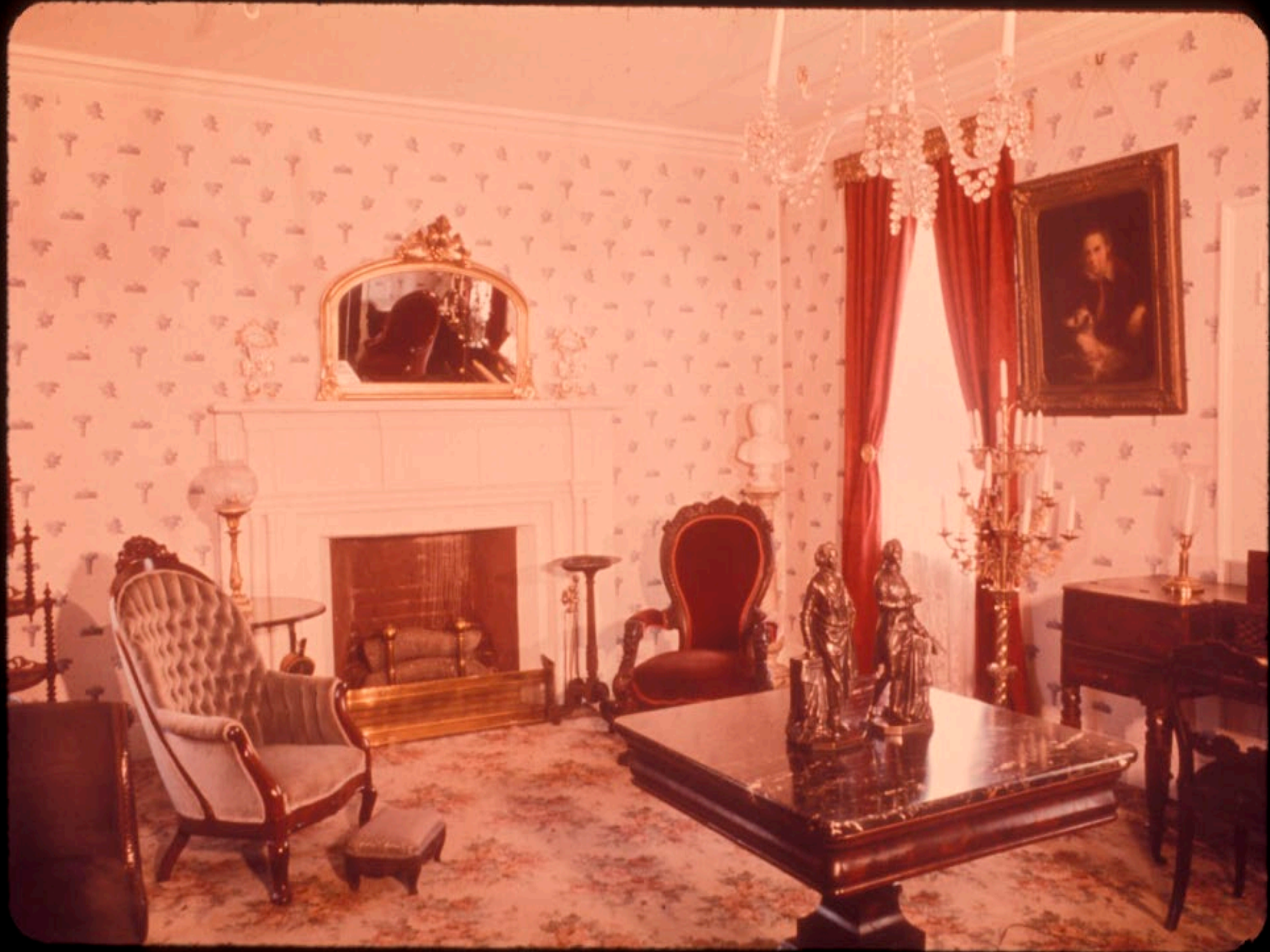

Before You Rush Out to Incorporate One or More Fire Protection Systems:

- Conduct a thorough risk assessment
- Do everything possible to reduce the exposed fuel loading
- Eliminate possible ignition sources and protect those that cannot be eliminated
- Establish and enforce fire safety protocols

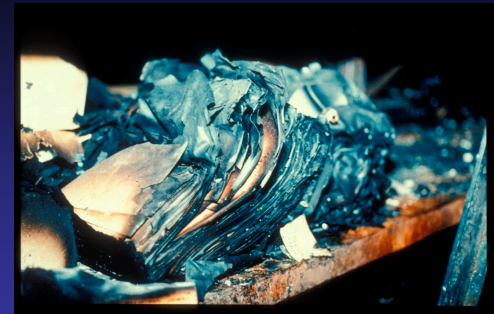
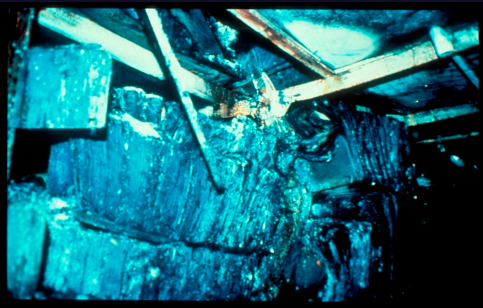

Once You Determine Fire Protection System Needs:

- Purchase from experienced, local companies with a reputation for outstanding support
- Check references of the installer
- Make sure everything works after it is installed!
- Ensure your system will be monitored and responded to 24 hours/day
- Keep it inspected, tested and maintained

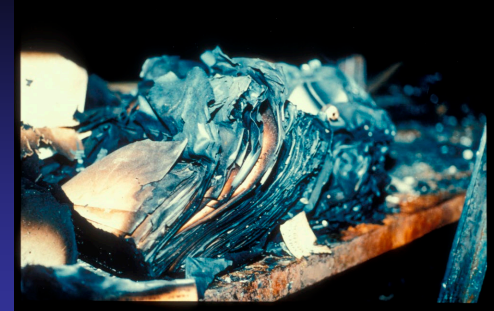
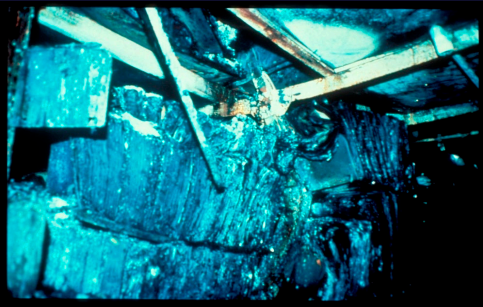
