Scope and Content

The materials in this series are a selective, not necessarily all-inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of FOIA request 2023-0070-F.

This series consists of a barcode scanning sheet, correspondence tracking sheet, notes, tab dividers, copies of outgoing correspondence from Vice President Cheney and his staff members David Addington and Cesar Conda, memoranda for the Vice President from Jonathan Burks, Cathie Martin and Eric Edelman advising him on his response to various recipients, originals and copies of letters addressed to the Vice President from various individuals, fax cover sheets, email printouts, and speech drafts. The processed records document correspondence with various individuals which occurred in October 2002. Most of the documents are dated October 2002, but a few are from July and September 2002.

The responsive records processed in response to this FOIA request relate to a letter Vice President Cheney sent to Harlan Crow and his wife congratulating them on the birth of their child. All other records within the file relate to correspondence with other individuals and cover a variety of topics. These letters relate to thank you responses for gifts, congratulations for various achievements, responses to views on domestic and foreign topics, letters of recommendation, and responses to invitations. Correspondents include family and friends of John A. Chapman, Representatives Wolf and Gibbons, British Columbia's Premier Gordon Campbell and Senator Mike Enzi.

System of Arrangement

Records responsive to this FOIA request were found in Cheney Vice Presidential Records: White House Staff Member and Office Files.

Staff Member and Office Files are the textual records created and/or maintained by White House staff members within their individual offices. These files document all levels of administration activity.

Staff Member and Office Files are processed at the folder level, and the documents within are maintained in their original order. Since the files are processed at the folder level, individual documents contained within these folders may not be wholly responsive to the subject area of this FOIA request.
