##### **Extent**

84 pages

##### **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Gore Vice Presidential records is governed by the Presidential Records Act, as amended (PRA) (44 USC 2201-2209) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 USC 552, as amended) and therefore may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

##### **Copyright**

Records in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States Government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. ##### **Provenance**

Official records of the Albert Gore vice presidency are in the custody of the Archival Operations Division in Washington, DC and are administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act, as amended (PRA).

### **Scope and Content**

Under requirements of the Ethics in Government Act, Senior United States Government officials must follow detailed requirements regarding public financial disclosures. Disclosures are captured via the Executive Branch Personnel Public Financial Disclosure Reports (also known as Office of Government Ethics Form 278). In the Clinton administration, these forms were initially submitted to the White House Counsel's Office for review. The Counsel's Office organized the forms by the year the form was prepared, which covered the previous calendar year. The forms were ultimately submitted to the Office of Government Ethics (OGE), under the Department of Justice.

The records include Vice President Al Gore's financial disclosures created in the years 1994-2000 covering the years 1993-1999. Records also include memos from the Vice President's Counsel to the Office of Government Ethics dated May 15, 1995 and November 15, 1999, confirming transmittal of the forms covering the year 1994 and amending the forms for the year 1999, respectively. The financial disclosures include documentation of Vice President Al Gore's assets and income; financial liabilities; positions held outside the U.S. government; and gifts, reimbursements, and travel expenses.

### **System of Arrangement**

Records responsive to this FOIA request were found in Gore Vice Presidential Records: White House Staff Member and Office Files.

Staff Member and Office Files are the textual records created and/or maintained by White House staff members within their individual offices. These files document all levels of administration activity.

Staff Member and Office Files are processed at the folder level, and the documents within are maintained in their original order. Since the files are processed at the folder level, individual documents contained within these folders may not be wholly responsive to the subject area of this FOIA request.
