TEXT:

A few items of note today:

1. POTUS Sched. He announces new student loan default rates today (this is not expected to be very big news), and then does the Arts and Humanities awards.

2. New Problem. The Globe today has a story about a Miami businessman who donated \$50,000 to the DNC, and, as a result, got the Peruvian Economics Minister in to see the President at a White House coffee (at a time when the President of Peru could not get time with the President). 5. Simon Replacement. With (b)(6) fading, I am starting some more outside the box/restructuring thinking. Particularly with (b)(6) and Tom Kalil at NEC prepared to dually report to you, and Kohlenberger, there is an opening here for going with a free agent pick. Or, alternatively, we could put Bob M. Rubin in Greg's slot and use the salary

savings to give some of the raises I am being pressed for (e.g., Leon F, and Charles Burson if he accepts wants \$25k more than Kumiki makes) and to upgrade the Press Secretary job .
