The National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) has reviewed your agency's responses to the allegations of unauthorized disposition of archival records made by Mr. Carl Schreier in a letter dated 6 October 2017, sent to the Archivist of the United States. National Park Service (NPS) responses were provided by Yellowstone National Park Superintendent, Mr. Daniel Wenk, in a memo dated November 22, 2016, and a follow up email dated February 8, 2016, from NPS archivist, Ms. Anne Foster. All allegations were thoroughly addressed by staff at NPS and Yellowstone National Park. Based on these responses, and NARA's independent review, we are unable to substantiate any of the allegations raised by Mr. Schreier, and as a result, we are closing our file on this case.

Please find enclosed for your file copies of letters sent by NARA's Chief Operating Officer, Mr. William Bosanko, notifying Mr. Schreier and Mr. Wenk of the case findings and closure.
