What is ERA?

Electronic Records Archives

- A technology system and workflow management program designed to store and manage NARA's electronic records and to manage the lifecycle of paper records & other holdings
- **Free from dependence** on any specific hardware or software

ERA is.....

- Electronic/digital system
 - Supports lifecycle management of temporary & permanent records
 - Scheduling, transferring, receiving, preserving, & accessioning
- Management Program
 - Manages lifecycle of all records, both digital and non-digital
 - Facilitates easy retrieval of e-records

ERA helps NARA's mission


- ✓ Makes Government records available for future



ERA Functionality




ERA Virtual Workspaces
