The Bureau of Entomology and Plant Quarantine was abolished by Secretary of Agriculture's Memorandum No. 1320, suppl. 4, November 2, 1953, with functions transferred to the Entomology Research, Plant Pest Control, and Plant Quarantine Branches of the Agricultural Research Service, and to the Forest Insect Research and Blister Rust Control Divisions of the Forest Service.
