<i>1.</i>	<p>This agency requests disposal authority for 24 cu. ft. of unscheduled mineral interest records presently stored in the Washington National Records Center. These records consist of copies of documents concerning the sales of mineral interests owned by the United States on real estate acquired by it through programs administered by Farmers Home Administration and its predecessors. These mineral interests were reserved by a covenant in the deed executed by the United States when Government-owned land was sold to individuals under Farmers Home Administration and predecessor agency programs. Public Law 760, 81st Congress (7 U.S.C. 1033) provided for sale of these reserved mineral interests to the surface owners. Mineral interests unsold as of September 1957 were transferred from the Department of Agriculture to the Department of Interior.</p> <p><i>Some of</i> These records are covered by Accession No. 096-68C3469, Boxes 23-47, covering a period from 1950 to 1958 <i>and any accretions.</i></p> <p>We request that this past accumulation of records, which are no longer generated, be retained until October 1, 1988, and then destroyed.</p>
