1	<p><u>Aerial Photography Files</u></p> <p>Color and black and white negatives of domestic farmland created for ASCS to make acreage determinations, insure compliance with planting regulations, and carry out other programs as required by the Agriculture Act of 1938. ASCS selects areas to be filmed on a need basis, but each county is normally photographed once every 8 to 10 years. Contract pilots do the filming and furnish ASCS with 9.5 inch wide negatives in rolls 250 feet long. APFO has film from 1941 to present totaling 47,000 rolls (9800 cu. ft.) and current annual accumulation is approximately 800 rolls (167 cu. ft.). From these negatives APFO makes over 1 million photographic reproductions for other USDA and Federal agencies and the general public.</p> <p><u>DISPOSITION:</u> <u>Permanent</u>.
