The purpose of the program was to resolve "problems related to finding new or improved methods of utilizing agricultural materials, wastes, and byproducts."</p> <p>1. The records consist of proposals for line projects, authorizations or withdrawals, requests for extensions or discontinuances, with related correspondence.
