The BAI was established in 1884 to deal with prevention, control, and eradication of animal diseases and parasites; conduct research on production of live- stock and their products; perform inspection duties; and otherwise seek to protect and develop livestock, meat, poultry, and related industries. In 1953 the BAI was terminated and most of its duties were assumed by ARS.
