	Attached is a description and proposed disposition for the documentation of system testing for Y2K compliance in the Food and Nutrition Service, USDA Record Group 462		

1. Store Tracking and Redemption Subsystem (STARS). Data pertaining to the entire food coupon redemption process, from presentation of coupons in stores to destruction at Federal Reserve Banks. Information entered by filed offices includes: stores, authorized to redeem coupons as well as data pertaining to open, closed, and pending wholesaler/retailer case investigations.

- a. These documents (15 cubic feet) contain test scripts and test results for verifying the STARS system for Y2K compliance.

Disposition: (Temporary) Cut off at completion of project. Transfer to Federal Records Center when 1 year old. Destroy when 3 years old.

- b. These documents (1 cubic feet) contain change enhancement requests to make changes to the STARS system for meeting the Y2K compliance.

Disposition: (Temporary) Cut off at completion of project. Transfer to Federal Records Center when 1 year old. Destroy when 3 years old.

- c. These documents (1 cubic feet) contain the meeting minutes for the STARS system in order to meet the Y2K compliance.

Disposition: (Temporary) Cut off at completion of project. Transfer to Federal Records Center when 1 year old. Destroy when 10 years old.

2. Food Program Integrated Information System (FSPIIS). Supports administration of the Food Stamp Program via subsystems.

These documents (65 cubic feet) contain test scripts and test results for verifying the FSPIIS subsystems for Y2K compliance.

Disposition: (Temporary) Cut off at completion of project. Transfer to Federal Records Center when 1 year old. Destroy when 3 years old.

3. Special Nutrition Programs Integrated Information System (SNPIIS). Seven subsystems which support the entry of program financial data for the Child Nutrition Programs; The Nutritional Education and Training Program; The Supplemental Food Program for Women, Infants, and Children; the Commodity Supplemental Food Program; the Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations; the Nutrition Program for the Elderly and the Emergency Food Assistance Program.

These documents (30 cubic feet) contain test scripts and test results for verifying the SNPIIS subsystems for Y2K compliance.
