	Description : The Fast Antimicrobial Screen Testing Program (FAST) database is a biological screening test for the detection of antimicrobial residues in animal tissues. It is designed to be performed by a veterinarian or a designated food inspector in a slaughtering plant.		
	FAST is based on the principle that if animal tissue contains a residue of previously administered antimicrobial, fluid from the tissue will inhibit the growth of a sensitive organism on a bacterial culture plate. FAST can be applied any time the veterinarian suspects the presence of an antimicrobial residue. This test is also used for follow-up testing of animals from previously identified violators.
