1. POLICY

Research or analysis of the grain, livestock, meat packing, or poultry industries conducted by GIPSA personnel

Disposition: Temporary

Recordkeeping Copies: Destroy when no longer needed by GIPSA

6. DATA

Data obtained through standard reports, outside sources, or from the following types of investigations

- 1 Competition investigations,
- 2 Investigations involving major or national firms,
- 3 Investigations involving more than 1 regional office,

- 4 Investigations requiring large expenditures of resources, or
- 5 Other investigations as designated by the Deputy Administrator
