


Small Area Model-Based Estimates

These estimates are national in scope, combine survey data with population estimates and administrative records, and result in papers, publications, and other public releases. They are ongoing program activities rather than one-time projects.

Two such activities are the Small Area Income and Poverty Estimates (SAIPE) and the Small Area Health Insurance Estimates (SAHIE).

SAIPE provides the only source of single-year estimates of income and poverty for all counties and poverty for all school districts in the U.S., regardless of population size. SAIPE is produced annually for the U.S. Department of Education to meet the requirements of Title I of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965, as reauthorized by the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (20 USC 6301 et seq.).

SAHIE provides the only source of single-year estimates of health insurance coverage for all counties in the U.S., regardless of population size. SAHIE is produced annually.
