ED's are Census designated statistical areas used to control the collection and tabulation of data at the lowest level (an ED averages roughly 800 people or 250 housing units) and which are hierarchically nested within all other politically defined or Census designated areas. Each ED listing contains the 1960 population count, the 1960 housing unit count, the ED number, the area name, and geographic codes for the state/county/congressional district/minor civil division/ward tract in which the ED was located.
