Documentation includes mimeographed, narrative summaries of reconnaisance photographs; the photographs themselves; and, multi-colored, printed target charts describing bombing targets in China. 	The second records series consists of <u>Joint Army/Navy Intelligence Survey (JANIS) Reports produced by the Research and Analysis Branch, Office of Strategic Services. These date from August, 1945 and deal with conditions in China for that time period.  The inclusive dates for both series range from October, 1944 through August, 1945. The files are classified, CONFIDENTIAL, and total approximately one cubic foot.</u>
