

Two, distinct records series comprise the file.</p> <p>The first series consists of photo interpretation files generated by the 18th Photo Intelligence Detachment; Headquarters, 14th Air Force. Documentation includes mimeographed, narrative summaries of reconnaissance photographs; the photographs themselves; and, multi-colored, printed target charts describing bombing targets in China. These are generally arranged in chronological order.</p> <p>The second records series consists of Joint Army/Navy Intelligence Survey (JANIS) Reports produced by the Research and Analysis Branch, Office of Strategic Services. These date from August, 1945 and deal with conditions in China for that time period.</p> <p>The inclusive dates for both series range from October, 1944 through August, 1945.
