**NAME OF SYSTEM:** vTrack Vessel Monitoring System (VMS)

**DESCRIPTION:** VMS is a tool for the management of all federally permitted fishing vessels and provides current location data to all Magnusson partners. The system enables National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's (NOAA) Office for Law Enforcement (OLE) agents and officers to display information using map overlays placed in the application for management areas to assist in Fisheries Management.

**Input**

Data entered into the system by the OLE help desk, support staff, and electronic inputs consisting of name, address, vessels, cases, and location. Data is also from interface with Interconnect Service Agreements (ISA) with the Northeast Region and Science Center, and Southeast Fisheries Science Center.

~~Disposition: **TEMPORARY.** Delete when data have been entered into the master file or database and verified, or when no longer needed to support reconstruction of, or serve as backup to, the master file or database, whichever is later. **GRS 20, Electronic Records, item 2(b).**~~

**Item 2: Master File.**

Data input includes positional records created depending on the particular fishery requirement, one position every 30 minutes, or 60 minutes, positional data, name, and location.

Disposition **TEMPORARY.** Delete/destroy 10 years after current data is migrated to a new system and verified or after termination of the system.

**Item 3: Output**

This system provides OLE employees, contractors, with visual mapping through a web interface (full screen view of data), reports and vessel information downloadable to spreadsheet data.

Disposition. **TEMPORARY.** Delete when the agency determines that they are no longer needed for administrative, legal, audit, or other operational purposes.
