The mission of the NOAA Corps is to provide officers technically competent to assume positions of leadership in NOAA's programs. Members of a Uniformed Service, they serve as officers of the Department of Commerce, or as military officers if transferred to the Armed Forces during times of war or national emergency.

The Act of May 18, 1920 [41 Stat. 603, 33 USC 864] established basic parity between the Coast and Geodetic Survey Officers and Navy Officers by equating their pay and retirement laws.

The NOAA Corps is one of the seven Uniformed Services of the United States [37 USC 101 (3)].

Pursuant to the provisions of 33 USC 857-3, active service of officers of the NOAA Corps or ~~(its)~~ predecessor organizations is deemed to be active military service in the Armed Forces of the United States for the purposes of all rights, privileges, immunities, and benefits provided by:

- (1) Laws administered by the Veterans Administration;
- (2) Laws administered by the Interstate Commerce Commission;
- (3) The Soldiers' and Sailors' Civil Relief Act of 1940, as amended [50 USC App. 501 et seq.] .
