	<p>National Oceanic &amp; Atmospheric Administration Disposal Authority, NNL71-114, approved April 7, 1971 is amended to read:</p> <p><u>Strip Charts</u> - Containing continuously recorded oceanographic data obtained by electronic recording devices lowered in the ocean. Such devices included the Expendable Bathythermograph (XBT) and the Salinity/Temperature/Depth (STD) instrument. The charts together with related log sheets are forwarded to the NODC by various data contributors. Each batch of data is assigned an identity number for processing purposes. Data from selected standard depth intervals are digitized by or for the NODC and recorded in either the XBT or the STD data base.</p> <p>After processing, transfer to Washington National Records Center. Destroy <del>20</del> <sup>5</sup> years after processing.</p> <p><i>Use telephone conversation with Charlotte Ashby 9/1/74</i></p> <p><i>1 item</i></p>
