Nairobi Protocol File - Documents relating to the management and operation of the program dealing with the duty-free import of articles for the handicapped. File contains such records as the Articles for Physically or Mentally Handicapped Persons (Form ITA-326P) and related materials. The Nairobi Protocol legislation contains a safeguard provision which can be used by domestic manufacturers to limit certain duty-free treatment if the President determines that the duty-free imports are having a significant adverse impact on the domestic industry. The information provided on the form will assist in making the adverse impact determination.
