All of the material contained therein is obsolete.</p> <p>These files do not contain social security numbers and each time DIA receives an FOIA request and there is a name match, the file must be retrieved only to discover the file is not the one in question. The large volume of obsolete records is creating needless work and problems for both DIA and the Federal Records Center.
