1	<p>OFFICIAL PHOTOGRAPHY OF ATMOSPHERIC NUCLEAR TESTING PROGRAM. 1946-1958</p> <p>Still photography file of the Atmospheric Nuclear Test Program (1946-1958) conducted by the Defense Nuclear Agency (DNA) and predecessor Organizations: Defense Atomic Support Agency (DASA) and Armed Forces Special Weapons Project (AFSWP). Photographs are arranged in 13 subseries corresponding to the atmospheric tests conducted during the period. Coverage for each test consists of pre-test site photos, photos of the detonation, and post test site photography. Series consist of ca. 970 jacketed captioned negatives mostly 4x5 with a few 5x5, 8x10, and 9x9; and captioned contact prints. Approximately 50% of the photos are color. All photos are unclassified and cleared for public release.
