	<p>LEGAL ADMINISTRATION (Table 110-1) (Applicable to HQ USAF/JAI)</p> <p>The purpose of this submission is to revise Table 110-1 to add Rule 16.1 (attached). This rule covers foreign civil litigation records in which the Air Force or one of its agents is named as a party. Although the Department of Justice defends each of the cases, it does not retain a complete case file on each decision. Legal decisions rendered in foreign courts often have precedential value for future cases in that country, and even in similar cases being defended by the U.S. government in other countries.
