| 1 | <p>AIR FORCE TRANSITION PROGRAM (Table 35-11) (Applicable Air Force Manpower and Personnel Center)</p> <p>The purpose of this submission is to have rule 1.1 appraised as permanent records. The Transition Program was established by Executive Order in June 1967 and was implemented in the Air Force in January 1968. The primary objective of the program was to assist airmen leaving the service to qualify for and obtain civilian employment. The Air Force did support the program. However, the program lost funding and was discontinued in the fall of 1973. There are 16 cubic feet of records of rule 1.1 at the WNRC that documents the Air Force participation in Project Transition.</p> <p>To the best of our knowledge, this is the only time such a project was initiated and pursued in the Air Force. From that point of view, the records in rule 1.1 have historical significance. The plight of the Vietnam veteran has been a very popular subject through the years. These records may prove to be of value to historical researchers, since the Project Transition was a positive program to help.</p> <p><i>Mass data change sheet required.
