The documents fall under file number 1513-03, Hydrological and Hydraulic Data Files, AR 340-18-15, and are presently listed as permanent. We intended to offer these tapes to the National Archives. However, prior coordination with Mr. Don Harrison, Machine-readable Archives Division, indicates that the records possess insufficient archival value to be accessioned into the National Archives. The records are presently stored in the Washington National Records Center.</p> <p><i>Disposition: Temporary.
