Background Information

AR 700-80, Army In-Transit Visibility. This regulation sets policy, responsibilities, and standards for implementation of the Army In-Transit Visibility (ITV) capability. The ITV is a critical component of force visibility and asset visibility (AV), providing commanders the information needed to conduct operations. The Department of Defense (DOD) definition of ITV is the ability to track the identity, status, and location of DOD units, and nonunit cargo (excluding bulk petroleum, oils, and lubricants) and passengers; patients; and personal property from origin to consignee or destination across the range of military operations. The proponent of this regulation is the Deputy Chief of Staff, G-4. In support of AR 700-80, the U.S. Army Sustainment Command, U.S. Army Materiel Command, submits for disposition the Army Mobility Asset Tracking System (AMATS). AMATS is an information assurance compliant system that collects logistic and positioning data on a central server for use by logistics personnel to determine the location of assets at any time in a depot or maintenance area. Source input data originates from file uploads, scanned and keyed data and is approved for disposition under RN25-1kkk. Output includes inventory and accountability reports and are covered under RN25-1jjjj. System documentation includes record layouts, specifications, and code books which are covered under RN 25-1mm. The inclusive dates of AMATS records are from 2011 to present.
