Informant cards and cross index cards: Destroy in CFA 3 years after termination of informant's service. <p><u>BACKGROUND INFORMATION:</u></p> <p>Request for records disposition approval, Job Number NCI-AU-79-38, dated 8 March 1979, Informants file, did not address the Level I Drug Suppressant Program or "Other elements."</p> <p>An increase in drug trafficking and smuggling has made a longer retention of these records essential. Level I Drug Suppression Team (a team of covert investigators in numerous areas) are normally involved in several independent covert operations accompanied only by informants during initial contact with a narcotics trafficker. Level I informants in the Drug Suppression Program frequently resurface following a period of dormancy which may range from a few months to several years. The increased retention periods requested above will facilitate drug suppression operations by allowing undercover CID agents to review the dossier of resurfaced informants up to 10 years after they became inactive.</p>
