Background Information The Media Exploitation Set-Light (MEDEX-L) is a suite of state-of-the-market equipment modules used by Marine Corps Counter Intelligence/Human Intelligence (CI/HUMINT) to gather information or data from various types of electronic devices. The system allows each CI/HUMINT Exploitation Team to collect, receive, process, and disseminate CI/HUMINT information from overt, controlled, sensitive, technical, tactical, CI/Force Protection, and HUMINT operations. MEDEX-L is used to support operations and exercises in garrison, overseas, shipboard, and tactical environments. Inclusive dates: from 20110701 ongoing.
