Approximately 2300 original pencil Drawings of navigational and piloting equipment and subcomponents such as gyro compasses, test equipment, wiring diagrams, compensating binacles, patch pannels, repeaters, magnetic shields, etc. These sketches numbered Sk.N-1 through Sk.N-2067 (some sketch numbers have multiple sheets) were produced by the navigation lab at New York Naval Shipyard and transferred to the Naval Air Development Center, Warminster, PA when the New York Yard was closed and the function was transferred to the Global Positioning Navigation Branch at NADC.

Drawings have been filmed in aperture card format in accordance with standards set forth in 36 CFR Part 1230. Storage conditions for archival copy conform to American National Standards Institute (ANSI) standards. Filmed records are in the NAVSEA Code Identification # 52125 series. Film has been verified.

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DISPOSITION:

A. Original Drawings: Destroy after verification that the microform meets prescribed quality standards and that the microform is an adequate substitute for the original document.

B. Microform aperture cards:

(1.) One silver halide set and one diazo or vesicular copy. PERMANENT Retain on board until cancelled or superceded then retire to FRC Philadelphia in annual blocks. Transfer to NARA 10 years after superceded.

(2.) Other microform copies. Destroy when no longer needed for current operations.
