The system contains a reporting and data analysis function that allows these individuals, as well as the component level program managers, to analyze data and trends by generating reports based upon a number of variables for different periods of time. The cornerstone of this function is the ability to maintain historical data records in the DIUCS database. The reports generated are derived from the source records in the database. Removing records from the database would reduce the accuracy and range of the reports thus having an adverse effect on data analysis.	GRS 1 Item 31

BACKGROUND: The Defense Injury and Unemployment Compensation System is a web-based Department of Defense wide system for the processing of Federal Employee Compensation Act claims seeking monetary, medical and similar benefits for injuries or death sustained by civilian employees while performing assigned duties.

Records are maintained for the purpose of auditing the State itemized listing of Unemployment Compensation charges, identifying erroneous charges and requesting credits from State Employment Security Agencies, and tracking the charges to ensure that credits are received from the appropriate State jurisdictions

Inputs: Include but are not limited to name, address, telephone on individual claims submitted by authorized personnel

System interfaces for personnel and pay information from the Defense Civilian Personnel Data System (DCPDS) (schedule pending), DFAS Civilian Pay System and Department of Labor system. Claims data is inputted to the Department of Labor via the Electronic Data Interchange **(GRS 20 Item 2c)**

Outputs: System outputs include but are not limited to injury compensation claims, incident notification and auditing records. System interfaces also include personnel and pay information from the Defense Civilian Personnel Data System (DCPDS), DFAS Civilian Pay System and Department of Labor system. **(GRS 20 Item 16)**

System documentation will be kept in accordance with GRS 20, Item 11(a)(1)
