These consist of health care records for all in-house animal populations of the LAM maintained by the Veterinary Medicine Division and include SF 600, "Chronological Record of Medical Care," weight charts, records of surgical procedures, anesthesiology records. Files are grouped by species (dogs, goats, pigs, cats, pigeons, etc.) and within species by USDA tag number or LAM's internal control numbers.

<u>Disposition</u>: Cut off 3 years after death of animal or 3 years after completion of protocol, whichever is later. At the end of this period animal health records and protocols will be destroyed.
