Background Information      In Orders Nos. 888/889 the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission suggested the concept of an Independent System Operator as one way for existing tight power pools to satisfy the requirement of providing non-discriminatory access to transmission. As a result, Order No. 2000, (NOPR Rulemaking RM99-2) issued December 20, 1999, encouraged the voluntary formation of Regional Transmission Organizations (RTOs) throughout North America (including Canada) to monitor, control and coordinate the interstate electricity transmission grid.

As Codified in 18 C.F.R. 35.34 (c)(2), (g) (203), Order No. 2000 requires utilities to report to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission the status of pertinent RTO formation and development; the obstacles that have prevented the filing of an appropriate RTO proposal; and any of the public utility's plans and timetable for future efforts directed toward RTO formation and participation.

1	<p><b>Regional Transmission Organization Filings (RT Dockets)</b> Independent System Operators grew out of Orders Nos. 888/889 where the Commission suggested the concept of an Independent System Operator as one way for existing tight power pools to satisfy the requirement of providing non-discriminatory access to transmission. Subsequently, in Order No. 2000, the Commission encouraged the voluntary formation of Regional Transmission Organizations to administer the transmission grid on a regional basis throughout North America (including Canada). Order No. 2000 delineated twelve characteristics and functions that an entity must satisfy in order to become a Regional Transmission Organization.</p>
