Description The Virtual Agenda System supports FERC in meeting its obligations as prescribed in the Government in the Sunshine Act

- This system controls FERC Orders in draft electronic format
- It allows authorized FERC staff to make requests for documents in docketed proceedings to be reviewed, modified and voted on by the Commissioners
- It allows for draft orders to be scheduled for Commission meetings or removed from further consideration
- It allows for items to be requested for tolling, where the Commission stops the 30-day deadline for rehearing orders

Virtual Agenda tracks work items through various phases of the Commission's business processes until a decision is rendered by the Commissioners. Once voting has been completed for each draft order, it is either approved for publication, or temporarily or permanently stricken from the Agenda.

During the course of processing, the system generates email notifications to specified FERC user groups. Status information is also available through queries and from online reports

At various phases of processing, descriptive administrative detail information can be added, including descriptions of issues related to documents, process selections, participant lists/roles/contact information, statuses and other administrative information

The system also generates formal documentation of proceedings, including Sunshine Act records, which are automatically published to the Commission's On-Line Document Repository after approved, formally posted, and publicly issued

These Sunshine Act records are maintained by the Secretary of the Commission and are provided to the National Archives in the current record series "Minutes of Commission Meeting Records" (N1-138-88-2, FRSII/II/1/B) "Secretary's Meeting Folders" will be superseded by this schedule (N1-138-88-2, FRSII/II/1/C)
