Appraisal – The Office of Scientific and Technical Information (OSTI) provides a centralized base of support for DOE and its contractors to assist in scientific and technical

information activities and services the DOE community by providing access to all DOE scientific and technical research reports. In addition, the collection is in support of the Energy Policy Act of 2005 also referred to as Public Law 109-58, Subtitle G-Science, Section 982 - Office of Scientific and Technical Information which states: "The Secretary, through the Office of Scientific and Technical Information, shall maintain within the Department publicly available collections of scientific and technical information resulting from research, development, demonstration, and commercial applications activities supported by the Department." The Collection is used daily for reference, research, duplication, and dissemination to authorized recipients. For example, there were over 38 million accesses to OSTI's unclassified systems in FY 2005. Information is also exchanged with the Department of Defense and to a lesser degree with other agencies via approved mechanisms. Unlimited access documents are made available to the public primarily via DOE Information Bridge, http://www.osti.gov/bridge/, the National Technical Information Service (NTIS), and the Government Printing Office (GPO) Depository Libraries.

Prior to FY 2000, DOE and its Contractors were required to send hard copy of their STI products to OSTI for archiving and preservation purposes. Effective FY 2000, OSTI established a policy for DOE and Contractor Offices to submit scientific and technical information products in an electronic format. Metadata describing the electronic documents are provided via a web form or an XML file. Acceptable formats for electronic records submission are: Adobe Acrobat Portable Document Format (PDF) and Microsoft Word Documents (all MS Word documents are converted to PDF format as part of record processing). In 1998, OSTI began scanning its pre-1995 paper documents. Paper documents received since 1995 have been scanned and converted to PDF format.

Based on OSTI's role within the Department of Energy in support of Departmental research activities, the incorporation of this activity into OSTI's current operations, and per guidelines presented in 36 CFR Part 1220, the following disposition is requested:
