Appraisal - The Office of Scientific and Technical Information (OSTI) provides a centralized base of support for DOE and its contractors to assist in scientific and technical information activities, and services the DOE community by providing access to all DOE scientific and technical research reports. These activities are in support of 42 USC 5916 which states that DOE is to develop and maintain a central source of information on all energy sources and technology in support of R&D and demonstration missions. Collection is used daily for reference, duplication, and dissemination to authorized recipients. Therefore, these records are deemed permanent.

OSTI is currently implementing an archival plan to comply with the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) guidelines applicable to disposition and transfer of permanent records while ensuring that regular current business of the agency will be continued. Based on this plan, and the approval of this Request for Records Disposition Authority, OSTI will transfer subsets of this series to NARA in accordance with 36 CFR Part 1228.190. Each subset transferred will be accompanied by an electronic index to allow access to the collection. This index will be cumulative and updated for each subset transferred to provide a single comprehensive index to the records series. Based on OSTI's role within DOE in support of Departmental research activities, the incorporation of this activity into OSTI's current operation, and per guidelines presented in 36 CFR Part 1220, the following disposition is requested:
