Applications for approval to market medicated animal feeds are now being processed on a "generic" rather than a "brand name" basis. This will result in fewer applications received and the withdrawal of a prior application(s) on approval of a new one for the same generic product. Brand name applications are submitted on form FD-1800. Generic applications will be on form FD-1800 also until new form FD-1900 is put in use. We are therefore requesting the removal of medicated animal feed applications from item V-1 and placing them in new item V-23.</p> <p><u>Medicated Feed Applications</u></p> <p>Applications from producers of medicated animal feeds to market their products. Applications include three copies of form FD-1800 or FD-1900, Medicated Feed Application; labels and promotional material; supplements; Agency evaluations with supporting material; notices of approval; related correspondence; and other documentation.</p> |                      |                  |
