(1)	<p><u>Draft and Final Environmental Impact Statements (EIS) prepared by HEW.</u></p> <p>EISs assess the environmental impact of an action or actions taken by HEW. The EISs are distributed to other federal agencies and to public and private groups for review and comment. Final EISs must address written comments on the draft EIS submitted by reviewers.</p> <p>Destroy when Retention period - six years old.</p>		
(2)	<p><u>Draft and Final Limited Impact Statements prepared by HEW.</u></p> <p>Limited Impact statements assess environmental impacts that are not considered to be "significant" and therefore do not require preparation of an EIS. The documents must be made available to the public upon request but do not require distribution. Retention period - six years old.</p>		<i>Destroy when</i>
(3)	<p><u>Environmental Analyses prepared by HEW.</u></p> <p>Environmental Analyses are the documents used to support the decision to prepare either an EIS or limited impact statement.</p>

(4)	<p><u>Categorical Exclusions</u></p> <p>Categorical exclusions are analyses that are prepared by HEW program staff which may determine that program actions are not capable of creating significant environmental impact and therefore exclude that program activity from any further consideration of the need for an environmental analysis, or environmental impact statement.</p> <p><i>Destroy on</i> Retention - To be retained until expiration of the authority for the activity covered by the analyses, or two years after supercession by revised analysis, whichever is sooner.</p>		
(5)	<p><u>Draft Environmental Impact Statement prepared by other federal agencies and sent to HEW for review and comment.</u></p> <p>The National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) requires federal agencies to send EISs to other federal agencies</p>

The external EISs are reviewed by HEW, and if they involve impacts within the jurisdiction or technical expertise of HEW, comments are prepared and forwarded to the originating agency.</p> <p>Retention - The EISs on which comments are submitted will be retained with the comments for one year, or as follows, whichever is less: <i>and then destroyed when one year old</i></p> <p>(a) 30 days after issuance of a final EIS (b) an amended draft has been issued (c) the proposed undertaking has been cancelled.</p>
