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

1.	<p><u>HCFA ELECTRONIC RECORDS SCHEDULE.</u> Contains data collected to manage and administer Medicare, Medicaid and other health care services, delivery and financing programs of the Health Care Financing Administration.</p> <p><u>Physician Practice Cost and Income Survey (PPCIS)</u></p> <p>The PPCIS system contains data collected to develop a Geographic Cost Practice Index, refine the cost share weights of the Medicare Economic Index, and evaluate Federal Reimbursement of physicians participating in Medicare and Medicaid. Includes a sample of approximately 5,000 physicians who provide patient care at least 20 hours per week in an office or hospital setting, and who live in the 50 States and the District of Columbia. The data include information on practice costs such as rent for space and equipment, employee salaries and compensation, malpractice insurance, physician gross and net income, and related fees and costs. Includes the 1983 PPCIS and its follow-up surveys.</p>
