Item 1 AHRQ National Resource Center (NRC) Health Information Technology (HIT) Content Management System

The National Resource Center (NRC) Health Information Technology (HIT) portal is a database and website used to disseminate information about AHRQ Health IT activities. It provides a searchable knowledge library and taxonomy of Health IT related-information in order to share best practices to help accelerate the adoption of Health IT throughout the nation.

(Note: The NRC HIT Portal website is scheduled under the AHRQ web schedule, N1-510-09-12.)

- a. Master file Content includes electronic copies of resources relating to Health IT such as grant research findings, reports, surveys, white papers, reviews, project findings, best practices, news announcements, event descriptions, case studies, and recordings of teleconferences.
