Background Information	The Federally Supported Health Centers Assistance Act of 1992 and 1995 granted medical malpractice liability protection through the Federal Tort Claims Act (FTCA) to HRSA-supported health centers. Under the Act, health centers are considered Federal employees and are immune from lawsuits, with the Federal government functionally acting as primary insurer. To receive coverage, grantees must submit an initial deeming application to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Health Resources and Services Administration, Bureau of Primary Health Care (BPHC) and meet the requirements to attain deemed status. Renewal applications for redeeming must be submitted on an annual basis to continue coverage.	
	A deemed health center, its employees, and eligible contractors working within the approved scope of project are considered federal employees and are immune from lawsuits for medical malpractice. A patient who alleges acts of medical malpractice by a deemed health center cannot sue the health center or the provider(s) directly, but must file the claim against the United States Government. The Federal government assumes responsibility for costs related to a claim resulting from the performance of a medical, surgical, dental, or related function. There is no cost to a participating health center or its providers. These claims are reviewed and/or litigated by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Office of the General Counsel (OGC) and the Department of Justice according to FTCA requirements.

	The Claims Analysis Review and Tracking (CART) system is a web-based system designed to facilitate the review, retrieval, storing, and processing of medical malpractice claims in anticipation and support of litigation by the OGC under the FTCA. Case files contain data on petitions for compensation, including petitioner's name and name of person allegedly damaged, if different from petitioner and all relevant medical records. This system contains relevant medical, legal, demographical and payment information to be used in case related defense of the United Stated Federal government. All case-specific documentation related to the claims is stored electronically within the system, in common formats such as Adobe PDF. All documents are attached to the related claim. The CART system is fully contained within the HRSA network and adheres to all HRSA security regulations and requirements. The system's role-based user access reduces the potential for unnecessary exposure or loss of sensitive date (i.e., HIPAA violations).
