

Originally designed to assist in the location of Area Health Education centers, the file now provides a wide range of information on health facilities, health professions, geographic codes and descriptors, health facilities utilization, economic activity, population characteristics, measures of resource scarcity, health status, health professions training programs, demographics, vital statistics, and socioeconomic and environmental characteristics for all counties or their equivalents in the United States. The information is collected from a wide variety of sources including the U.S. Census Bureau, Bureau of Labor Statistics, Health Care Financing Administration, National Center for Health Statistics, and the American Medical Association.
