SAFECOM Baseline Searchable Database System

The SAFECOM Baseline Searchable Database is a web-based system serving as a data retention and reporting tool that allows users to run customized queries and generate reports based on the results of the National Interoperability Baseline Survey. In addition, survey data may be used to guide and measure the effectiveness of future communications interoperability improvement efforts that local, tribal, state, and federal public safety organizations execute.

The system is authorized to operate in its existing operating environment for a period of three years as stated in an October 17, 2007 letter from Dr. David Boyd with subject header "Security Accreditation Decision for SAFECOM Baseline Searchable Database System." While in operation, the system satisfies DHS continuous monitoring activities and undergoes a system security control review on an annual basis. Every three years or if a major change is made to the system, the system is recertified and accredited.

The survey questions assessed the stage of development of responding agencies in each of five critical areas (governance (administration and decision making), standard operating procedures (SOPs), technology, training and exercises, and usage).
