ICEGangs

ICEGangs is a web-based system utilized by the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) National Gang Unit to record, track, and analyze information on gangs, gang activities, and suspected or confirmed gang members, and their associates

Gangs are defined as a formal or informal group, club, organization or association, of three (3) or more persons, that has as one of its purposes the commission of criminal activity in the United States or outside of the United States, committed two (2) or more criminal acts on separate or distinct occasions, and the members of which may share a common identifying sign, symbol or name
