2 Victim Notification Tracking System

The VNP utilizes the Victim Notification Tracking System (VNTS) as a database to track registered victims of crimes that are committed by aliens along with the alien offender information. Once a victim or witness submits the Victim Request form to register with the program, the information they provide on the form is transcribed into the VNTS for automated tracking. Once the alien is set for release from custody and/or removal from the United States, VNP personnel updates VNTS with this information as well. ICE Enforcement and Removal Operations (ERO) personnel are tasked with providing the actual notification to the victim or witness of the alien offender's release/removal information. This notification is via telephone call or by additional letter.

2(a) **INPUT**:

Victim Request for Notification of Criminal Alien Status Form

The Victim-Request for Notification of Criminal Alien Status form provides a method for the victim to transmit the information that is maintained in the system. Registering victims and witnesses voluntarily provide known information about themselves and the criminal alien that committed the offense against them or their property or to which they witnessed committing an offense.
