Background Information

SEMOSS is a business/data analytic toolkit that provides the ability to explore and find connections between CBP OIT application metadata stored in multiple repositories to provide a richer and more complete analysis. SEMOSS displays data from one or more databases, including Graph, Relational Database Service (RDS), or noSQL (non-Structured Query Language), in a network graph, grid or spanning tree. These data are currently stored in the Relational Database Framework (RDF), which is also known as a Graph Database. The RDF is a database that stores the connections and visualizations that the SEMOSS tool makes. These views can be customized, overlaid, and extended to allow identification of data fields in data sources that address specific information needs. CBP uses SEMOSS to consolidate Enterprise Architecture (EA) data from various sources, such as user input or automatic data feeds, for centralized data analytics and visualization and for portfolio management purposes.
