


Customs Automated Inventory & Maintenance Tracking System (CAMITS)

CAMITS is a database program which processes information for all vessels. It stores and tracks inventory management, maintenance information, and operational readiness as well as providing ad hoc reports.

Disposition. **TEMPORARY.** Cut off at the end of the calendar year in which the vessel related to records is disposed. Destroy/Delete 6 years after cutoff.
